



Percentage of Cancers Probably Caused by HPV




HPV causes nearly all cervical cancers and many cancers of the vagina, vulva, penis, anus, rectum and oropharynx.



State vs. U.S. HPV-Associated Cancer Incidence per 100,000 Population (2016-2020)




HPV, Tdap and MenACWY Vaccination Coverage Percentage among Adolescents 13-17 Years (2022)
